BIKER DAY AT WHITE CREEK

Members of Christian Motorcyclists Association are with us today, to bring a report and information concerning "Run For The Son," which we have supported for a number of years.

Pastor Sam has been a member of CMA since 1985, and he and Beverly were instrumental in starting the local CMA chapter, Son Light Riders around the turn of the century. Since we came to White Creek in 2011, the Church has generously supported the activities of the chapter, and specifically, Run For The Son. The Church has provided space in the basement for monthly meetings (during the winter months) and we have supported the ministries of CMA, Open Doors, Missionary Ventures, and The Jesus Film, by giving to the yearly fund-raiser, "Run For The Son."

For the last few years, the Run for the Son ride has gone from Mauston, Wisconsin to "The High Ground," a Veteran's Memorial near Neillsville, WI. In years past, folks would pledge to give a certain amount per mile, for each rider that made the ride, but the policy today is basically to ask each donor to give whatever the Lord leads them to give. During the service today, and each week in April, we are asking

each one to give to this ministry as God directs, so we can gather the total on the first Saturday of May. We then ride to the High Ground in celebration for what the Lord has blessed us with. Each of the last two years, CMA has received over five million dollars for missions through Run for the Son. None of this offering goes to operating expenses; it all goes to home and foreign missions. CMA extends its thanks and appreciation to all who help support this world-wide ministry. Anyone who would like to join this ride, or go along in your car, are welcome to come and celebrate with us. Just let us know.
