CONSIDER THIS

I read more and more every day about how awful things are in this world. It's like reading parts of the Bible, describing how things were during the days of the Judges, or the histories of Kings and Chronicles! We could even find New Testament and extra-biblical narrations of how things were in the first century. The Lord, Himself, describes these days in Matthew 24 and other places, such as this:

And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world? And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. (Matthew 24:3-8)

Many have taken opportunity to preach on these things so that we may be aware of what is coming, so we can prepare for it. I believe that it is important to know what's coming, but the preparations begin in our hearts and minds. If we are not spiritually ready for the enemy's attack, no amount of ammunition and armament is going to help us. If we are not totally committed to Jesus Christ and His Kingdom, we cannot win against Satan and his cohorts. Pray, and seek God in these days. Prepare your heart for what's coming!
