#### **CONSIDER THIS**

Today is recognized by Christians around the world as "Palm Sunday."



I grew up in Southern California, where there are millions of palm trees. These trees are very plentiful in more "tropical" climates than you will find in Wisconsin. When we moved here over thirty years ago, we realized we were saying goodbye to the ocean, the mountains, the desert, and palm trees, among other things. The land where Jesus lived two thousand years ago had all those things that we were used to, and palm trees became a significant part of His story, as He rode into Jerusalem just a week before His death.

As the crowds welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem on the 10<sup>th</sup> of Nisan, about A.D. 30, they spread their coats, as well as tree branches on the road before him, as they would honor a King or Potentate into the city. This was a high honor, paid to a victorious leader, indicating that even the dust of the roadway was not worthy to touch the hooves of the donkey He was riding. It would have been fairly easy to find fallen palm branches to use, or to even cut them from some of the lower trees lining the road. As He passed by, those coats and branches would be taken up and placed in front of the entourage again, and again. What a view of the glory of the "King of Kings." May we so honor Him in our hearts, today.
