CONSIDER THIS

I want to thank all of you for your prayers and blessings, and words of kindness on my birthday. There are reasons why I am like I am, and one of the main ones is that I have been around so many old people for so long. Beverly has been trying to figure out what to get me for my birthday - what can you get a guy who has everything and can't remember where anything is?

Larry sent her a note yesterday about a conversion kit he saw advertised down in Kentucky, that will put training wheels on my Harley, so I can keep riding motorcycles. Actually, a conversion kit bolts on the motorcycle frame and adds two wheels to the two already there. Not to be shown up by Larry, I went on-line and found a kit in Denton, Texas, for even less money, that (I am purely guessing on this) may be the right color for my motorcycle. I also guess I'd have to go pick up either one if she bought it for my birthday!

As I was doing my research on this, I found out that this kit will convert any motorcycle into a much more stable, safe and comfortable ride. It costs much less than a true trike conversion, which takes off the one rear tire and replaces it with a different rear axle and two tires. The kit slightly affects how you ride the motorcycle, but it doesn't affect gas mileage at all. It is simple to put on, and you can even take it off in about 30 minutes if you want to go back and ride on two wheels.

This got me to thinking how many people try to do that with their Christian conversion. They really don't want a full conversion, because they would have to give up so many things of the world, but they want to go to heaven when they die. I want to be able to live a good life and be a blessing to others, but there are some things that don't please God that I want to retain. So I go for a "conversion kit" because it doesn't really take anything away, and if I want to retain or go back to an old "habit" I can still do it. And the bottom line is so important; it won't cost me as much as a full conversion. Of course, the real question in this situation is, "Do I realize that the "kit" is not the "real thing?" It may not be that big a difference on a motorcycle, but why would I risk my eternal destiny on a "conversion kit?"
