As I write this, Beverly and I are in Tomah, Wisconsin at the Christian Motorcyclists' Association Annual State Rally, called "The Badger State Rumble." This is like our annual Party where we get together and recount the bike stories from the past, and set plans and goals for the future. This year, we are also celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> Birthday of CMA, so there are extra thoughts concerning the ministry we have doing for the past half century. I have actually been a member since 1985, when there were less than 20 thousand of us, mostly in the southern United States. Today, there are over a quarter of a million of us, spread out over the entire globe, in every continent, except, maybe, Antarctica.

Millions of people have heard and responded to the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the personal witness or the mission efforts of CMAers. Millions of dollars have been collected and sent directly to mission agencies for the purpose of directly sharing the GOSPEL MESSAGE. We give glory to God for the giving and serving of so many humble "bikers" through the years, going to the highways and byways of the world with the Word of Life for a lost and dying world.

One reason for sharing these thoughts with you is that for the last 15 years, you have been partners with us in this ministry, and we want to give God thanks for YOU. The other reason is that we have some problems to face during the days ahead. As I sat yesterday, visiting with old acquaintances, some of whom I had not seen for a year or more, I realized that most of the folks I was seeing were, to put it bluntly, OLD, like me. We have grown old together, doing what we do, and seeing God's blessings through the years. Our problem is not just that we are getting old, but there are few young men and women who are ready to take our place. If we do not reach this younger generation, CMA will fade away as its membership rides off into the sunset of time.

But the main reason for writing this to you is that I look around White Creek Church and see much the same thing happening. We have a wealth of elderly folks who have been and continue to be faithful to the work of God. We have a few of middle age who are willing to pick up the responsibilities of keeping the fire burning. Where are the youth who will be raised up to pick up the torch of Jesus Christ? We have a few who will one day bear the standard, but perhaps too few to meet the challenge. Our replacements must be enlisted in our cause. Those days of need are here, the challenge is great; the cry goes forth, "Whom shall I send and who will go for us?" Where are those who will answer, "Here am I; send me!" Pastor Sam
