CONSIDER THIS

Today we celebrate Palm Sunday, remembering the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem, just a week before His journey in a human frame was to end. For about 33 years, He walked this earth as the "God-man" and gathered around Himself those who would continue to spread the Gospel, long after His ascension. On this day, a multitude of people gathered to welcome the "Son of David" - Messiah into the Holy City, with cries of Hosanna, as they spread their coats and branches from the nearby trees on the road before Him. We refer to this Sunday as "Palm Sunday" as we remember this honor bestowed upon the Royal Conquering King victoriously entering the Capitol City.

In reality, His life had been a supreme example of what a life pleasing to God would be like, although it would be another week before His work on earth would be finished. There was much more to do, that would complete the redemptive mission that He had begun. Many of those who welcomed Him that day, would, in a few days, demand that He be crucified as a criminal. In one week, an illustration of the history of the world would be demonstrated, and then remedied. Mankind had existed, in the beginning, in fellowship with God, but soon decided to go their own way, disobeying the very One Who had created them. Those who gladly accepted Him as King, couldn't get rid of Him fast enough.

But, God knew all of this from the beginning. It was all part of the plan. It was prophesied hundreds and thousands of years before, that this very event in history would take place. The sacrificial system of the Old Testament was an every-day

depiction that would soon be fulfilled as Jesus Christ was beaten, mocked, and hung on a cross, to suffer and die for the sins of the world. The devil would have his day, and the evils of hell would rejoice for a moment . . . but only for a moment. The grave could never hold Him. Death could never defeat Him. The world could wallow in its sin, but it could never overcome the Righteous One, Jesus.

Neither can any of these nefarious forces overwhelm those who place their faith in Jesus Christ, as Savior and Lord. When Jesus uttered the words, "It is finished," and three days later the grave gave up His glorified body, the victory was secured for all of us who have believed His word. Even if we are called upon to go through the struggles and troubles that this life throws at us, we know that the victory has already been won. We know that we have Eternal Life because of His promise to never leave us or forsake us. He is, even now, preparing a dwelling place for us in heaven, a perfect place of peace and rest. If you do not know Jesus, would you come to Him, in faith, believing, and surrendering your life to Him, today. Don't miss this.
