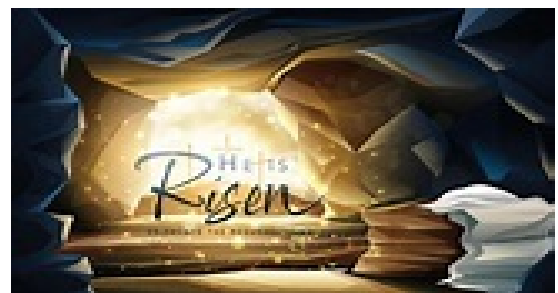

# RESURRECTION SUNDAY

## COUNTDOWN TO RESURRECTION

Holy Week, also known as Passion Week, follows the final days of Jesus' earthly ministry in 1st-century Jerusalem. Based on the synoptic Gospels and the Gospel of John, the timeline unfolds as follows:

### **Palm Sunday: The Triumphal Entry**

Jesus enters Jerusalem riding a donkey, fulfilling the prophecy of Zechariah 9:9. The crowds spread cloaks and palm branches on the road, shouting "Hosanna!"

Scripture: Matthew 21:1–11, Mark 11:1–11,  
Luke 19:28–44, John 12:12–19

### **Holy Monday: Cleansing the Temple**

Jesus returns to the city from Bethany and clears the Temple courts of money changers and merchants, declaring it a "house of prayer."

Scripture: Matthew 21:12–17, Mark 11:15–19,  
Luke 19:45–48

### **Holy Tuesday: Teaching and Controversy**

Jesus spends the day teaching in the Temple, engaging in various parables and debates with religious leaders (Pharisees and Sadducees) regarding authority, taxes, and the resurrection. Later, on the Mount of Olives, He delivers the "Olivet Discourse" concerning the end times.

Scripture: Matthew 21:23–24:51, Mark 11:20–13:37,  
Luke 20:1–21:36

### **Spy Wednesday: The Plot to Betray**

Jesus remains in Bethany, Judas Iscariot meets with the Sanhedrin (the high priests) and agrees to betray Jesus for thirty pieces of silver.

Scripture: Matthew 26:14–16, Mark 14:10–11, Luke 22:3–6

### **Maundy Thursday: The Last Supper**

Jesus shares the Passover meal with His disciples, instituting the Lord's Supper and washing their feet as an act of humility. Later that night, in the Garden of Gethsemane, He is arrested after Judas identifies Him with a kiss.

Scripture: Matthew 26:17–75, Mark 14:12–72,  
Luke 22:7–71, John 13:1–18:27

### **Good Friday: Trial, Crucifixion, and Burial**

After a series of overnight trials before Annas, Caiaphas, the Sanhedrin, Pilate, and Herod, Jesus is sentenced to death. He is crucified at Golgotha. He dies mid-afternoon and is buried in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea before sundown.

Scripture: Matthew 27:1–61, Mark 15:1–47, Luke 23:1–56, John 18:28–19:42

### **Holy Saturday: The Guarded Tomb**

Jesus' body remains in the tomb. Because it is the Sabbath, the disciples rest. At the request of the Jewish leaders, Pilate orders the tomb to be sealed and guarded by Roman soldiers to prevent the body from being stolen.

Scripture: Matthew 27:62–66

### **Easter Sunday: The Resurrection**

Early in the morning, women (including Mary Magdalene) visit the tomb and find the stone rolled away and the tomb empty. Angels announce that Jesus has risen. He subsequently appears to Mary, the disciples, and many others.

Scripture: Matthew 28:1–15, Mark 16:1–8, Luke 24:1–49, John 20:1–21:25
