Our prayers should not be limited to once a year, or only on special occasions. Prayer is NOT to be considered a duty, but a privilege. We should be utilizing that privilege more often.

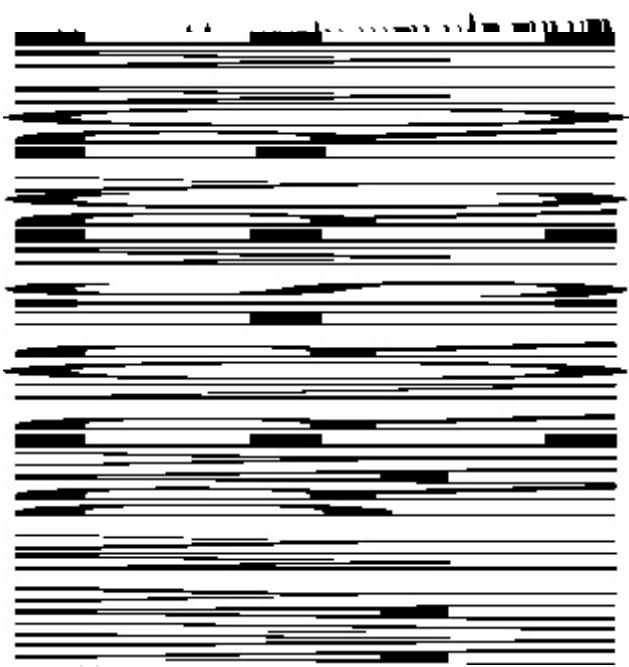
