CONSIDER THIS

Many Christians today have turned from the "cross" to a "Life Coach." A so-called Jesus has become their friend and coach through life's challenges.

When the Bible declares, "No one understands; no one seeks for God. All have turned aside; together they have become worthless..." (Romans 3:11-12) This is the coach's Diagnosis: You have a lack of clarity, limiting beliefs, or a failure to find one's "true north." You are just "feeling stuck" or out of alignment with your inner values. We will design a mindfulness routine to help you seek identity and inner peace.

The phrase "together they have become worthless" should be rejected entirely as toxic to self-esteem. "You are inherently enough; you just need to reframe your mindset and unlock your potential."

Considering this vision, "Their throat is an open grave; they use their tongues to deceive. The venom of asps is under their lips. Their mouth is full of curses and bitterness," (Romans. 13-14) I, as Life Coach, would Diagnose: Poor

communication skills, unresolved trauma, or a toxic environment. My Prescription: Deceit, cursing, and bitterness are treated as "maladaptive coping mechanisms." I recommend a workshop on "Nonviolent Communication" or assertiveness training. "Your bitter speech is just a defense mechanism because your boundaries were violated in the past. Let's work on your emotional intelligence and choose more positive, life-affirming vocabulary." You need to develop better communication habits.

About the section, "Their feet are swift to shed blood; in their paths are ruin and misery, and the way of peace they do not know." (Romans 3: 15-17) The Diagnosis: Poor stress management, impulse control issues, or systemic burnout. Prescription: This should be viewed as a failure of conflict resolution or "lacking a work-life balance." You need to learn anger management techniques, counting to ten, or removing "toxic people" from your life to protect their personal peace.

"The way of peace" becomes a destination achieved through yoga, meditation apps, or a weekend wellness retreat, rather than reconciliation with a holy God.

"There is no fear of God before their eyes." (Romans 3:18) Diagnosis: Co-dependency on external authority or a lack of self-empowerment. Prescription: "fearing" any external authority is a negative thing that limits personal freedom. You must shift the focus entirely inward: "You shouldn't worry about what an external judge thinks. You need to become the author of your own life. Release the guilt, step into your own power, and live your truth."

This is not only the advice you might get from a secular Life Coach, but it is now common to hear these same messages from pulpits in evangelical churches that have adopted the principles of the world. God has an entirely different plan for dealing with sin and overcoming evil in this world.

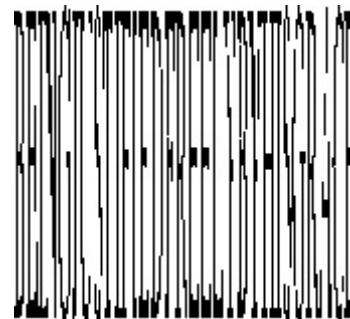
