CONSIDER THIS

We are approaching a very important section of Scripture, beginning with today's emphasis on Romans 5:18-21. "Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. 19 For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. 20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: 21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord."

The next three chapters in Romans are critical for the vitality of the Christian Life. We will be unable to attain what the Apostle has in mind for us - indeed God's original design, if we fail to see what the Spirit has awaiting us in this section. Of course, we must understand some things about the "sin" problem, so we begin in these verses above. I usually do not try to exert pressure on folks to do more than they are presently doing, because I want them to be listening to the urging of the Lord, but now I am beseeching you to be present for the messages to come, for your edification. If you miss, you can ask for a recording of the service, so you will not leave undone what God wants done.
